

Supporting and Leading Educational Change

This 12 week online course is designed to accredit and advance your work in supporting and leading educational change in further or higher education. Successful completion confers eligibility for Fellowship of SEDA (FSEDA). See the SEDA website for details of the Fellowship scheme (http://seda.ac.uk/professional-development.html?p=3_2).

The course will be delivered over two 6 week blocks (October 29th to December 7th 2012, and January 7th to February 15th 2013). Participants will be supported by an experienced educational developer and peers. During the course you will be supported in developing an e-portfolio to demonstrate that you have met the course requirements. The portfolio may be used subsequently for PDP purposes.

The course is suitable for:

- School / faculty / department-based learning and teaching coordinators (with many different role titles)
- Staff from a range of developmental projects and initiatives of various scales, both internally and externally funded. Such projects and initiatives include HEFCE-funded initiatives including CETLs, Higher Education Academy Subject Centres and projects, learning and teaching strategies and widening participation and curriculum development initiatives
- Staff undertaking peer review; mentoring; provision of learning resources and support, including e-learning; programme and curriculum leadership and development
- Quality enhancement staff
- Staff leading and delivering postgraduate certificates in learning and teaching in higher education
- Staff of central educational development units.
