Higher Education in the UK has been subject to intensive scrutiny and regulation in the UK at least since the 1980s, with the introduction of internal cost-accounting and the beginnings of the assessment of research. Inspection of teaching was introduced in the late 1990s, and student fee regimes have changed several times, with significant undergraduate fees about to be introduced. While academics have complained about many of these measures governments argue that they have been highly effective: aspects of the British educational system remain highly attractive and competitive internationally, and other countries have followed parts of the UK model. In the talk Jonathan Wolff will discuss some of the major changes in recent decades and consider their advantages and disadvantages, and the lessons that may be learnt.

Norton), 2011. objavio je knjigu Ethics and Public Policy (Routledge). U koautorstvu s Avnerom de-Shalitom 2007. objavio je knjigu Disadvantage (Oxford University Press). 2003. Objavio je knjigu Why Read Marx Today? (Oxford University Press). Redoviti je kolumnist uglednog dnevnog lista The Guardian.
